SSP - External Student Athlete Criteria

- Golf Handicap entry level to program
 - Yr 9 - Boys 18.4 / Girls 24.4 or better
 - Yr 10 - Boys 12.4 / Girls 18.4 or better
 - Yr 11 - Boys 8.4 / Girls 12.4 or better
 - Yr 12 - Boys 6.4 / Girls 8.4 or better
- Have a Positive and enthusiastic attitude
- High level of coachability, to seek and accept a variety of feedback
- High level of ability to improve in all aspects of their schooling
- Be a positive role model for others in their approach to learning
- Maintain membership of a Golf SA affiliated Club

External Students are expected to:

- Show a desire to learn and to improve their skills and knowledge of the sport
- Complete all required theory work and tasks, thoroughly and on time
- Wear SSP Uniform at all related golf sessions and lessons
- Be active in the sport by competing at regular events
- Be a positive role model in their approach to school and program rules
- Provide own transport to and from sessions

Conditions of enrolment

Both Parents and Student of a successful application are required to sign a Student agreement form accepting the offer of a position in the Henley High School Specialist Sport Program. A student must agree to the terms and conditions of the Specialist Sport Program which are part of the agreement form.

Pathways
